COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 383, L.D. 557, Bill, "An Act Concerning the Commission on Governmental Ethics and Election Practices"

Amend the bill by striking out everything after the enacting clause and before the statement of fact and inserting in its place the following:

'1 MRSA §1002, sub-§2, as enacted by PL 1975, c. 621, §1, is amended to read:

2. Qualifications. The members of the commission shall must be persons of recognized judgment, probity and objectivity. No A person shall may not be appointed to this commission who is a member of the Legislature or who was a member of the previous Legislature, or who was a declared candidate for an elective county, state or federal office within 2 years prior to the appointment, or who now holds an elective county, state or federal office, or who is an officer of a political committee, party committee or political action committee.'

**STATEMENT OF FACT**

The amendment prohibits an officer of a political action committee, party committee or political committee from serving on the Commission on Governmental Ethics and Election Practices.
