STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED AND NINETY-ONE

An Act Concerning the Commission on Governmental Ethics and Election Practices.



Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:

1 MRSA \$1002, sub-\$2, as enacted by PL 1975, c. 621, §1, is amended to read:

2. Qualifications. The members of the commission shall must be persons of recognized judgment, probity and objectivity. No A person shall may not be appointed to this commission who is a member of the Legislature or who was a member of the previous Legislature, or who was a declared candidate for an elective county, state or federal office within 2 years prior to the appointment, or who now holds an elective county, state or federal office, or who is the treasurer of any political action committee.

STATEMENT OF FACT

This bill prohibits the appointment to the Commission on Governmental Ethics and Elections Practices of a person holding the position of treasurer of a political action committee.
