IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED AND NINETY-ONE

An Act to Increase Mobile Home Park License Fees.

(EMERGENCY)

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Emergency preamble. Whereas, Acts of the Legislature do not become effective until 90 days after adjournment unless enacted as emergencies; and

Whereas, it is vital that the funds provided in this legislation are available for the beginning of fiscal year 1991-92; and

8 Whereas, that fiscal year will begin before the expiration

10 of the 90-day period; and

12 Whereas, in the judgment of the Legislature, these facts create an emergency within the meaning of the Constitution of 14 Maine and require the following legislation as immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health and 16 safety; now, therefore,

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:

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10 MRSA §9083, first ¶, as repealed and replaced by PL 1985, c. 600, §2, is amended to read:

The board shall establish a fee for a license to operate a 24 mobile home park within the meaning of this subchapter. The fee shall must include a base fee of \$39 \$40 plus an additional 26 amount of up to \$3 \$4 per mobile home site. This fee must accompany each application for license, including applications 28 for mobile home park expansion and renewal of license.

Emergency clause. In view of the emergency cited in the preamble, this Act takes effect when approved.

STATEMENT OF FACT

36 Public Law 1989, chapters 271 and 690 authorized the Manufactured Housing Board to hire 2 additional field people and 38 one part-time clerical person. Neither bill provided funding for additional personnel and the board is in need of additional 40 revenue. To meet the existing financial obligations of the board, this bill increases the license fee from \$30 to \$40 and 42 the additional fee per mobile home site from \$3 to \$4.
