COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "7" to H.P. 395, L.D. 569, Bill, "An Act to Amend the Composition of the Board of Trustees of the Maine Technical College System"

Amend the bill by striking out everything after section 1 18 and before the statement of fact and inserting in its place the following:

'Sec. 2. 20-A MRSA §12705, sub-§1, as amended by PL 1989, c. 22 700, Pt. A, §67, is further amended to read:

24 1. Membership. The board of trustees shall--consist consists of 9 appointed voting members and 2 3 ex officior voting 26 members as follows:

28 Ar--One-from-the-State-Beard-of-Education;

C. Seven <u>Nine</u> from the field of business and industry, the field of labor, the field of education and the general public;

D. The Commissioner of Education, or the commissioner's successor, who shall-serve serves ex officio;

 40 E. The Commissioner of Economic and Community Development, or the commissioner's successor, who shall-serve serves ex 42 officio; and

44 F. The Commissioner of Labor, or the commissioner's successor, who shall-serve serves ex officio.

2 Appointment; terms. Members of the board of trustees 2. shall-be are appointed by the Governor to 4-year terms of office, subject to review by the joint standing committee of the 4 Legislature having jurisdiction over education and to 6 confirmation by the Legislature. In appointing members to the board, the Governor shall give proper consideration to achieving statewide geographical representation and gender equity. 8 No classified or unclassified employee of the State or person who holds elected state office may serve on the board of trustees, 10 with the exception of the ex officio members.

Sec. 4. Transition. The members of the State Board of
Education and the Board of Trustees of the University of Maine
System serving on the Board of Trustees of the Maine Technical
College System on the effective date of this Act may serve the
remainder of their terms. When their terms expire, sections 2
and 3 of this Act apply.'

## STATEMENT OF FACT

One member of the Board of Trustees of the University of 24 Maine System and one member of the State Board of Education are required to serve as members of the Board of Trustees of the 26 Maine Technical College System. This amendment revises the composition of the Board of Trustees of the Maine Technical College System by removing those 2 positions when the terms of 28 the 2 trustees currently serving expire. It maintains a 12-member board by increasing from 7 to 9 the number of 30 representatives from the general public and the fields of 32 business and industry, labor and education. It also adds language directing the Governor to consider statewide geographical representation and gender equity when appointing 34 · board members. 36
