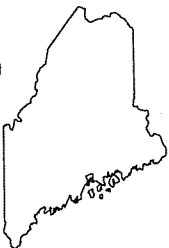

NINETEEN HUNDRED AND NINETY-ONE

An Act to Abolish the Pheasant Stamp Program.



Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:

2 **Sec. 1. 12 MRSA §7076, sub-§4,** as amended by PL 1989, c. 493,
4 §11, is further amended to read:

6 **4. Resident disabled war veterans.** A complimentary license
8 to hunt or fish, or a combination hunting and fishing license,
10 ~~and, if requested, a pheasant hunting permit~~ and a muzzle-loading
 hunting license under section 7107-A shall must be issued to any
 resident of Maine who:

12 A. Is a veteran, as defined in Title 37-B, section 505,
 subsection 1, paragraph A, subparagraph (5);

14 B. Has a service-connected disability evaluated at 70% or
16 more as a result of honorable military service;

18 C. Has served in a combat zone during either World War I,
 World War II, the Korean War or the Vietnam War; and

20 D. Applies for that license to the commissioner.

22 This application shall must be accompanied by a photo copy of the
24 applicant's final DD form 214 or other evidence satisfactory to
26 the commissioner that the applicant meets the requirements of
28 this subsection. Each license issued under this subsection shall
 ~~remain~~ remains valid through December 31st of the 2nd complete
 calendar year following the year of issuance.

32 repealed.

34 **Sec. 3. 12 MRSA §7405,** as enacted by PL 1979, c. 420, §1, is
36 repealed.
