An Act Concerning the Packaging of Soymilk.



,	Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:
2	32 MRSA §1868, sub-§4, as repealed and replaced by PL 1989

б	4. Aseptic and composite material beverage containers. In a container composed, in whole or in part, of aluminum and plastic
8	or of aluminum and paper in combination where those materials are for practical reasons inseparable.
