COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 1101, L.D. 1600, Bill, "An Act to Increase the Penalty for Failure to Secure a Child with a Seat Belt"

Amend the bill in subsection 4 in the 3rd line (page 1, line 8 in L.D.) by striking out the following: "\$25 ~~\$50~~" and inserting in its place the following: '\$25'

Further amend the bill by adding at the end before the statement of fact the following:

This bill increases the fine for subsequent violations of the child seat belt laws. There will be an increase in General Fund revenue from the collection of additional fines. The amount can not be determined at this time.'

This amendment strikes the increase in the fine for the first violation of the child seat belt law and retains the increase to \$200 for each subsequent violation. The amendment also adds a fiscal note to the bill.
