Amend the bill in Part $B$ in section $B-1$ in that part designated "HUMAN SERVICES, DEPARTMENT OF" under the caption "Administration - Regional - Human Services" by striking out all of lines 8 to 10 (page 241, lines 5 to 7 in L.D.) and inserting in their place the following: of funds to continue the closing of the same offices as in Public Law 1991, chapter 9 and no others, to'

Further amend the bill in Part $P$ by inserting after section P-13 the following:
'Sec. P-14. 22 MRSA §3174-F, sub-§1, đE, as enacted by PL 1989, C. 502, Pt. A, §72, is repealed.'

Further amend the bill in Part $P$ by renumbering the sections to read consecutively.

Further amend the bill by inserting at the end after the emergency clause the following:
