22	and such notice shall be entered on the journal. Notwithstanding this rule and Rule 53, after the convening of the First Regular
24	Session, and before January 26, 1993, any amendment to the House
	Rules proposed by a House Order may be adopted by a majority vote
26	in the House; except that, if the amendment has already failed to
	be adopted during that session, it may only be adopted if, upon
28	reconsideration, it receives the approval of two thirds of the
20	members present in the House.'
