HOUSE AMENDMENT " $H$ " to H.P. 1481, "JOINT RESOLUTION MEMORIALIZING THE ATTORNEY GENERAL OF THE STATE OF MAINE TO INITIATE A LAWSUIT AGAINST THE FEDERAL GOVERNMENT DUE TO ITS CONTINUING PRACTICE OF ENACTING UNFUNDED FEDERAL MANDATES THAT HAVE BEEN IMPOSED ON THE SEVERAL STATES AND THEIR POLITICAL SUBDIVISIONS"

Amend the Joint Resolution by striking out the last resolved paragraph and inserting in its place the following:
'RESOLVED: That suitable copies of this Memorial, duly authenticated by the Secretary of State, be transmitted to the Honorable William J. Clinton, President of the United States, to the President of the Senate and the Speaker of the House of Representatives of the Congress of the United States, to the Attorney General of the State of Maine and to each Member of the Maine Congressional Delegation.'
