Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:

Sec. 1. 29 MRSA §906 is enacted to read:

§906. Use of ATV by law enforcement officer

Notwithstanding section 242, subsection 1, paragraphs E and8E-1 and Title 12, sections 7856 and 7857, a law enforcement
officer may operate an all-terrain vehicle, as defined in Title1012, section 7851, subsection 2, on a public way or private road
during the scope of and while engaged in employment as a law12enforcement officer.

STATEMENT OF FACT

18 This bill allows a law enforcement officer to operate an ATV on public ways and private roads when engaged in employment as a law enforcement officer.
