SENATE AMENDMENT "" to COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 24, 14 L.D. 27, Bill, "An Act to Make Additional Appropriations and Allocations for the Expenditures of State Government for the 16 Fiscal Year Ending June 30, 1993"

18 Amend the amendment in Part T by striking out all of section 1 and inserting in its place the following:

'Sec. T-1. Authorization. Notwithstanding any other provision of law, the Department of Human Services may defer until July 15, 22 1993 any hospital payment due pursuant to compliance and settlement orders issued by the Maine Health Care Finance 24 Commission between February 1, 1993 and June 1, 1993 and any payments due 26 pursuant to revisions or adjustments to 8th-payment-year revenue limit obligations issued by the Maine 28 Health Care Finance Commission.'

30 Further amend the amendment in Part T by striking out all of sections 4 to 7.

Further amend the amendment by relettering or renumbering 34 any duplicative Part letter or section number to read consecutively.
