	Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:
2	Sec.1. 12 MRSA §6523-A is enacted to read:

6	<u>§6523-A. Ice fishing shack removal</u>
U	The owner of any shack or temporary structure used for ice
8	<u>fishing on frozen coastal waters shall remove the shack or</u>
10	temporary structure by March 15. Failure to comply with this section is a civil violation. The fine or penalty for conviction of violating this section must include the costs incurred in
12	removing any structure.

16	STATEMENT OF FACT
18	This bill sets March 15 as the date when all ice fishing
	shacks must be removed from tidal waters. The fine for violating
20	this requirement must include the cost of removing the structure.
