An Act Concerning Costs Related to Local Education Administration.



Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:

Sec. 1. 20-A MRSA §15603, sub-§2, ¶F, as enacted by PL 1991, c. 591, Pt. E, §14, is amended to read:

F. ~~One-half-of-salary~~ Salary and benefits costs for superintendents, assistant superintendents and, associate superintendents, business managers and all other nonteaching central office staff.

STATEMENT OF FACT

This bill requires school administrative units to use local funds to pay salary and benefit costs for nonteaching central office staff and prohibits the expenditure of state funds for that staff.
