IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED AND NINETY-THREE

An Act to Amend the Requirements for Notice of Public Proceedings of the Public Utilities Commission.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:

Sec. 1. 35-A MRSA §108, 2nd and last ¶¶, as enacted by PL 1987,
c. 614, §1, are repealed.

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STATEMENT OF FACT

This bill repeals the last 2 paragraphs of the Maine Revised Statutes, Title 35-A, section 108, which require the Public Utilities Commission to give notice of only those public proceedings where the commission will deal with the expenditure of public funds or taxation, or will adopt policy. The purpose of this change is to bring the Public Utilities Commission in line with similar provisions for other state agencies.
