An Act to Establish a Consistent Expiration Date for Shellfish Licenses and Marine Worm Digger's Licenses.

	Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:

6	2. Expiration. A license or certificate <u>issued by the</u> <u>commissioner</u> expires on December 31st of the year in which it is

12	A. A depuration certificate issued under section 6856 expires on April 30th of each year:
14	B. A shellfish license issued under section 6601 expires on
