Resolve, Concerning Long-term Protection from Low-level Radioactive Waste.

## Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:

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Sec. 1. Study authorized. Resolved: That the Low-level 4 Radioactive Waste Authority shall conduct an analysis and review of the feasibility of separating long-lived and short-lived radioactive waste streams in waste generated by the Maine Yankee 6 Atomic Power Company; and be it further 8 Sec. 2. Report. Resolved: That the Low-level Radioactive Waste Authority shall present its findings to the joint standing 10 committee of the Legislature having jurisdiction over energy and natural resource matters by November 1, 1993. 12 14 STATEMENT OF FACT 16 This resolve directs the Low-level Radioactive Waste Authority to study the feasibility of separating long-lived and 18 short-lived radioactive waste streams in waste from the Maine Yankee Atomic Power Company. 20

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
