STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED AND NINETY-THREE

An Act to Abolish the Lobster Promotion Board and Repeal the Fees Supporting its Operations.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows: Sec. 1. 5 MRSA §12004-H, sub-§14, as enacted by PL 1991, c. 523, §1, is repealed. Sec. 2. 12 MRSA c. 619, sub-c. III-A, as enacted by PL 1991, c. 523, \S 2, is repealed. Sec. 3. Application; revenues in fund. On the effective date of 21¹⁻¹ this Act, all balances in the Lobster Promotion Fund, as established in the Maine Revised Statutes, Title 12, section 6455, subsection 5, are transferred to the General Fund. STATEMENT OF FACT

This bill abolishes the Lobster Promotion Council and the surcharges that support its activities. On the effective date of this Act, any funds remaining in the Lobster Promotion Fund are 20 transferred to the General Fund.

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
