IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED AND NINETY-THREE

An Act to Preserve Existing Elementary Guidance Services in Public Schools.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows: 2 Sec. 1. 20-A MRSA §4502, sub-§5-A, as enacted by PL 1991, c. 4 622, Pt. X, §3, is amended to read: 6 5-A. Application. The provisions subsection of 5, paragraph H do not apply to the school years beginning in the fall of 1991, 1992, 1993, 1994 and 1995, except that elementary 8 schools and school administrative units are prohibited from 10 eliminating existing guidance and counseling programs for elementary school students. 12 STATEMENT OF FACT 14

This bill prohibits the elimination of existing guidance and counseling programs for elementary school students.

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
