An Act to Prohibit the Board of Land Surveyors from Enacting Continuing Education Rules.

Be i	it	enacted	by	the	People	of	the	State	of	Maine	as	follows:	
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		Sec. 1. 32 MRSA §13903, sub-§2, as enacted by PL 1989, c. 34	6,
4	§3,	is amended to read:	

2. Rules. The board may, in accordance with procedures established by the Maine Administrative Procedure Act, Title 5, chapter 375, adopt rules as-may-be-reasenably necessary for the proper performance of its duties and the administration of this chapter. The board may not adopt rules requiring a specific program of continuing education to qualify for relicensure.

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STATEMENT OF FACT

This bill rescinds the authority of the Board of Licensure of Professional Land Surveyors granted in the Maine Revised Statues, Title 10, section 8003, subsection 5, paragraph C to require a specific program of continuing education to qualify for relicensure.
