Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:

A. In addition to the payment of the refund value, the initiator of the deposit under section 1863-A, subsections 1, 2 and 4 shall reimburse the dealer or local redemption center for the cost of handling beverage containers subject to section 1863-A, in an amount that equals at least 360 $\frac{21/26}{2}$ per returned container.

B. In addition to the payment of the refund value, the initiator of the deposit under section 1863-A, subsection 3 shall reimburse the dealer or local redemption center for the cost of handling beverage containers subject to section 1863-A in an amount that equals at least 3¢ 2 1/2¢ per returned container. The initiator of the deposit may reimburse the dealer or local redemption center directly or indirectly through a contracted agent.

STATEMENT OF FACT

This bill changes the amount that beverage deposit initiators must reimburse the dealer or redemption center for the cost of handling beverage containers from 3¢ to 2 1/2¢ per container.
