	Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:
2	Sec. 1. 38 MRSA §353-A, sub-§1, as enacted by PL 1991, c. 384,
4	\$ and affected by $$$ 16, is amended to read:
6	1. Fees assessed. After the effective date of this
8	section, a licensee <u>other than a public school</u> must pay an annual fee assessed on the sum of all licensed allowable air pollutants, except for carbon monoxide, as follows:
