STATEMENT OF FACT

The bill increased the maximum civil penalty for cruelty to animals from \$500 to \$1,000. The amendment retains this change and requires courts to impose a minimum fine of \$100 for violation of the civil or criminal animal cruelty laws. The amendment also adds a fiscal note.
