§6956. Paravanes prohibited; southwestern Penobscot Bay

 A person may not use a paravane on a registered or
8 documented vessel in any coastal waters located within the area bounded by a line running easterly from the southernmost point of
10 Monroe Island to the westernmost point of Brimstone Island, then southerly to the westernmost point of Seal Island, then westerly
12 to the northernmost point of Large Green Island, then northerly to the southernmost point of Monroe Island. For the purposes of
14 this section, the term "paravane" means a device projecting underwater that is designed to stabilize a vessel.

STATEMENT OF FACT

20 This bill prohibits the use of paravanes by registered or documented vessels in an area of coastal waters located in the 22 southwestern Penobscot Bay area.
