Resolve, to Consolidate the University of Maine at Fort Kent into the University of Maine at Presque Isle.

2 Resolved: That the Board of Trustees of the University of Maine System is directed to develop a plan to move all programs and 4 services currently provided through the University of Maine at Fort Kent to the University of Maine at Presque Isle by September 6 1, 1995. The plan must include a description of the required personnel positions once consolidation has been completed and a 8 list of possible uses for the Fort Kent site following consolidation; and be it further

Sec. 2. Report. Resolved: That the Board of Trustees of the 12 University of Maine System shall present its plan for consolidation to the Joint Standing Committee on Appropriations 14 and Financial Affairs by March 1, 1994.

STATEMENT OF FACT

20 This bill directs the Board of Trustees of the University of Maine System to develop a plan for merging the University of 22 Maine at Fort Kent with the University of Maine at Presque Isle. The plan must be presented by March 1, 1994 and the merger 24 completed by September 1, 1995. The plan must also include suggestions for use of the Fort Kent site following the merger. 26

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
