2	become effective until 90 days after adjournment unless enacted as emergencies; and

6	Whereas, the 90-day period may not terminate until after the beginning of the next fiscal year; and
8	Whereas, the Department of Defense and Veterans' Services needs additional funding to purchase heating fuel for the
10	upcoming winter months; and
12	Whereas, in the judgment of the Legislature, these facts create an emergency within the meaning of the Constitution of
14	Maine and require the following legislation as immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health and
16	safety; now, therefore,
18	Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:
