An Act to Require Health Insurance to Pay for Weight-loss Programs.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:

Sec. 1. 24 MRSA §2320-C is enacted to read:

§2320-C. Weight-loss programs

Individual and group nonprofit medical services plan contracts and nonprofit health care plan contracts must provide coverage for weight-loss programs prescribed by a physician or surgeon licensed to practice in this State.

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Sec. 2. 24-A MRSA §§2745-C and 2837-C are enacted to read:

14 §2745-C. Weight-loss programs

16 Individual insurance policies, except those policies that cover only dental procedures, accidental injury or specific 18 diseases, must provide coverage for weight-loss programs prescribed by a physician or surgeon licensed to practice in this 20 State.

22 §2837-C. Weight-loss programs

 24 Group insurance policies, except those policies that cover only dental procedures, accidental injury or specific diseases,
26 must provide coverage for weight-loss programs prescribed by a physician or surgeon licensed to practice in this State.
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STATEMENT OF FACT

This bill requires health insurance policies to pay for 34 weight-loss programs prescribed by a licensed physician or surgeon.

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
