2	Sec. 1. 15 MRSA §5826 is enacted to read:

U	Except as provided in section 5821, all legitimately
8	acquired assets, including real and personal property, of a
10	person accused of a crime are protected from attachment under Title 14, chapter 507 and other civil proceedings to freeze
12	assets, to the extent these assets are needed to secure and compensate legal counsel for the accused person's criminal
,_ ,_	defense. This protection extends from the time of arrest or
14	indictment until judgment is entered.
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18	STATEMENT OF FACT
20	This bill protects legitimately acquired assets of persons accused of crimes from civil proceedings that might prevent an
22	accused person from using assets needed to secure legal counsel for a criminal defense.
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
