Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:
Sec. 1. P&SL 1975, c. 122 is repealed and the following
enacted in its place:
Sec. 1. Associate in Applied Science degrees. Educational
Associates, Inc., which does business as Andover College, may
confer Associate in Applied Science degrees upon all who
satisfactorily complete the courses of instruction as the
directors of the corporation may from time to time prescribe.
STATEMENT OF FACT
This bill allows Andover College to confer Associate in
Applied Science degrees.
