

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:

Sec. 1. 12 MRSA §7311, sub-§2, ¶C, as repealed and replaced by
PL 1989, c. 913, Pt. B, §4, is amended to read:

C. Be If an applicant for an initial guide license, be
currently certified in first aid through completion of any
standard first aid course that meets the criteria
established by rule of the commissioner; and

STATEMENT OF FACT

Under current law, all Maine guides must be currently
certified in first aid. This bill restricts application of this
requirement to persons seeking a Maine guide license for the
first time.
