1. Entitlement. If an employee who has not given notice of a claim of common law or statutory rights of action, or who has given the notice and has waived the claim or rights, as provided in section 301, receives a personal injury by accident arising out of and in the course of employment or is disabled by occupational disease, the employee must be paid compensation and furnished medical and other services by the employer who has assented to become subject to this Act.

## STATEMENT OF FACT

This bill restores workers' compensation entitlement to the 1974 standard of an injury by accident arising out of and in the course of employment.
