Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:

Sec. 1. 22 MRSA §3173-E is enacted to read:

<u>§3173-E.</u> Reimbursement for hearing aids

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The department shall apply the same client eligibility standards and shall provide the same level of reimbursement for purchase and maintenance of hearing aids under the United States Social Security Act, Title XIX, to boarding home residents as is provided to nursing home residents.

STATEMENT OF FACT

16 This bill requires the Department of Human Services to apply the same eligibility standards and level of reimbursement for 18 hearing aids for boarding home residents as apply to nursing home residents.
