COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A " to S.P. 120, L.D. 358, Bill, "An Act to Amend the Liquor Laws Pertaining to the Retail Sale of Wine"

Amend the bill by inserting before the statement of fact the following:

FISCAL NOTE

This bill will decrease the net profits received from the sale of wines with higher alcohol content at state and agency liquor stores by approximately \$698,380 annually. The estimated reductions of General Fund undedicated revenues are \$500,025 and \$698,380 in fiscal years 1993-94 and 1994-95, respectively.
