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2 STATEMENT OF FACT

This amendment adds language to ensure that a town or county receiving grant money for construction of a sand and salt storage facility under the 1992 Jobs Creation Bond Package or under the Community Development Block Grant Program is not reimbursed for that portion of expenses paid for with the grant. The amendment also adds a fiscal note.
