5. Penalty. Violation of this section is a traffic infraction, for which a forfeiture of net-mere-than-\$100-may-be assessed \$500 is assessed. In lieu of a forfeiture, performance of 100 hours of community service work may be required. The community service obligation must be discharged within one year of the date of conviction of a violation of this section.

## STATEMENT OF FACT

This bill increases the fine for operating a motor vehicle without insurance from an amount of up to \$100 to a fixed amount of \$500. In lieu of this fine, the court may order the defendant to perform community service work.
