

2 Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:

4 Sec. 1. 38 MRSA §584-F is enacted to read:

6 §584-F. Public notice of excessive ozone

8 Whenever the department anticipates that the level of ozone
10 in ambient air will exceed the photochemical oxidant standard
12 established in section 584-A, subsection 4, the department shall
14 inform the general public of the anticipated excessive ozone
16 level through the media, including newspapers, radio and
18 television.

STATEMENT OF FACT

This bill provides for public notice when the ozone level exceeds state standards.
