9. Rules. The commissioner may submit to the board new or amended rules for its adoption. Rules that contain a provision or provisions that are substantively inconsistent with regulations or standards enacted or promulgated by the Federal Government must be clearly identified for the board in the basis statement of the proposed rule. The basis statement must also contain a justification for the inconsistency with the federal rule or standard.

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STATEMENT OF FACT

This bill requires the Department of Environmental Protection to be clear in the rules that it submits to the Board of Environmental Protection about provisions that are inconsistent with federal rules or standards that regulate the same subject matter. This bill also requires the department to justify proposed inconsistencies with federal rules or standards.
