_	Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:
2	Sec. 1. 3 MRSA §21-A is enacted to read:
4	<u>§21-A. President of Senate; term limitation</u>

8	<u>A person may not serve as President of the Senate for more than 2 consecutive legislative bienniums.</u>
10	Sec. 2. 3 MRSA §41-A is enacted to read:
12	<u>§41-A. Speaker of House of Representatives; term limitation</u>
14	A person may not serve as Speaker of the House of
16	Representatives for more than 2 consecutive legislative bienniums.
18	Sec. 3. Retroactivity. This Act takes effect retroactively to December 2, 1992.
20	STATEMENT OF FACT

24	This bill limits the terms that the President of the Senate and the Speaker of the House of Representatives may serve to 2 consecutive legislative bienniums. Calculation of time served
26	begins with the First Regular Session of the 116th Legislature on December 2, 1992.
