7. Household income. "Household income" means all income received by all persons of a household in a calendar year while members of the household except that income earned by a dependent who is a full-time college student and resides at college for more than 6 months in any calendar year may be excluded from household income for the purpose of determining eligibility under this chapter.

Sec. 2. Application. This Act applies to the filing period beginning August 1, 1993.

STATEMENT OF FACT

This bill eliminates income earned by dependents who are full-time college students and live away from home for most of the year from consideration when determining household income.
