transfers to the H.O.M.E. Fund. Beginning in fiscal year 1995-96, the full amount of these reductions of state revenue from this tax, approximately \$1.4 million, will be shared equally by the General Fund and the H.O.M.E. Fund, an annual reduction of \$700,000 to each fund.'

## STATEMENT OF FACT

This amendment adds an effective date of January 1, 1995 and a fiscal note to the bill. The amendment also removes from the bill a grammatical change that was accomplished in Public Law 1993, chapter 398.

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
