Be it	enacted	by	the	Peopl	e of	the	State	of	Maine	as	follows:

Sec. 1. 20-A MRSA §15905, sub-§1, ¶C is enacted to read:

C. The state board may approve the expenditure of funds realized from savings related to an approved project budget for approved expenses within the district affected by the project. The state board shall establish a list of approved expense categories that applies to all districts.

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## STATEMENT OF FACT

This bill provides incentives to school districts undergoing a construction project to be cost effective by allowing the Department of Education to establish an approved list of expenses that the district may use anywhere within the district where the need is greatest. This provision is likely to discourage the purchase of additional approved equipment merely to use up the balance of construction funding.
