Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:

Sec. 1. 12 MRSA §7076, sub-§1, as amended by PL 1991, c. 17, \$1 and affected by \$2, is further amended to read:

Residents over 70 years of age. A complimentary license 6 1. to hunt, trap or fish, including an archery license under section 7102, and a muzzle-loading hunting license under section 7107-A and a permit to hunt antlerless deer under section 7457, must be issued to any resident of Maine who is 70 years of age or older 10 application to the commissioner. upon These complimentary 12 licenses, upon issuance, remain valid for the remainder of the life of the license holder, provided the license holder continues to satisfy the residency requirements set out in section 7001, 14 subsection 32 and provided the license is not revoked or Residents who apply for these complimentary licenses 16 suspended. at any time during the calendar year of their 70th birthday must be issued a license upon application, regardless of the actual 18 date during that calendar year in which they attain age 70. A quide license may be renewed without charge for any resident of 20 Maine who is 70 years of age or older upon application to the The application must be accompanied by a birth 22 commissioner. certificate or other certified evidence of the applicant's date When the holder of a license issued 24 of birth and residency. the under this subsection no longer satisfies residencv requirements set out in section 7001, subsection 32, the license 26 is no longer valid and further use of the license for purposes of 28 hunting, fishing or trapping constitutes a license violation under section 7371, subsection 3.

STATEMENT OF FACT

This bill allows residents over 70 years of age to hunt 36 antlerless deer without a permit.
