6	State's emergency medical services and the regional councils of

8	revenue may include, but are not limited to, assessing a fee on
	utilities, insurance premiums, auto registrations and operator's

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Sec. 2. Report. Resolved: That the Emergency Medical Services' Board shall submit a report of their activities pertaining to this resolve together with any recommended legislation to the Joint Standing Committee on Appropriations and Financial Affairs by November 15, 1993.
