

2           **Sec. 1. Study. Resolved:** That the Emergency Medical Services'  
3 Board, as established by the Maine Revised Statutes, Title 5,  
4 section 12004-A, subsection 15, is authorized to conduct a study  
5 for the purpose of identifying sources of revenue to be used to  
6 replace General Fund appropriation money for funding of the  
7 State's emergency medical services and the regional councils of  
8 the statewide emergency medical services system. The sources of  
9 revenue may include, but are not limited to, assessing a fee on  
10 utilities, insurance premiums, auto registrations and operator's  
11 licenses; and be it further

12           **Sec. 2. Report. Resolved:** That the Emergency Medical  
13 Services' Board shall submit a report of their activities  
14 pertaining to this resolve together with any recommended  
15 legislation to the Joint Standing Committee on Appropriations and  
16 Financial Affairs by November 15, 1993.

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#### STATEMENT OF FACT

22           This resolve authorizes the Emergency Medical Services'  
23 Board to conduct a study to identify alternate funding for the  
24 State's emergency medical services and the regional councils of
