COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to S.P. 234, L.D. 727, Bill, "An Act to Require Postgraduate Residency Training for Podiatric Medical Licensure and to Permit Temporary Residency Licensure"

Amend the bill in section 1 in that part designated "~~§3651-A.~~" in subsection 1 in the first line (page 1, line 7 in L.D.) by inserting after the following: "applicant" the following: 'who has graduated after January 1, 1991 from podiatric medical school as set forth in section 3651'

Further amend the bill in section 1 in that part designated "~~§3651-A.~~" in subsection 1 in the 2nd line (page 1, line 8 in L.D.) by striking out the following: "after July 1, 1995"

Further amend the bill in section 1 in that part designated "~~§3651-A.~~" in subsection 2 in the first line (page 1, line 14 in L.D.) by striking out the following: "After July 1, 1995, a" and inserting in its place the following: 'A'

Further amend the bill in section 1 in that part designated "~~§3651-A.~~" in subsection 2 in the first and 2nd lines (page 1, lines 14 and 15 in L.D.) by inserting after the following: "of podiatric medicine" the following: 'who has graduated after January 1, 1991 from podiatric medical school as set forth in section 3651'

Further amend the bill in section 1 in that part designated "~~§3651-A.~~" in subsection 2 in paragraph A in the 3rd line (page 1, line 21 in L.D.) by striking out the following: "section" and inserting in its place the following: 'chapter'

Further amend the bill in section 2 in that part designated "~~§3654.~~" in the first paragraph in the 4th to 6th lines from the end (page 2, lines 7 to 9. in L.D.) by striking out the

2 following: "from July 1, 1995 to June 30, 2000, the podiatrist
3 has fewer than 5 years' experience in the practice of podiatry,
4 the podiatrist must have" and inserting in its place the

7 Further amend the bill in section 2 in that part designated
8 "**\$3654.**" in the first paragraph in the 3rd line from the end
9 (page 2, line 10 in L.D.) by striking out the following: "3651"
10 and inserting in its place the following: '3651-A'

11 Further amend the bill in section 2 in that part designated
12 "**\$3654.**" in the first paragraph by striking out all of the last
13 sentence (page 2, lines 10 to 12 in L.D.)

14 Further amend the bill in section 2 in that part designated
15 "**\$3654.**" in the 2nd paragraph in the 8th and 9th lines (page 2,
16 lines 21 and 22 in L.D.) by striking out the following: "From
17 July 1, 1995 to June 30, 2000, an" and inserting in its place the
18 following: 'An' and in the 10th to 13th lines (page 2, lines 23
19 to 26 in L.D.) by striking out the following: "has at least 5
20 years' experience in the practice of podiatry is not required to
21 have completed a residency program in podiatric medicine. After
22 June 30, 2000, an applicant for licensure by endorsement" and
23 inserting in its place the following: 'graduated after January
24 1, 1991 from podiatric medical school as set forth in section
25 3651'

26 Further amend the bill by inserting at the end before the
27 statement of fact the following:

28 '**Sec. 3. Allocation.** The following funds are allocated from
29 Other Special Revenue funds to carry out the purposes of this Act.
