HOUSE AMENDMENT "A" to COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 546,
L.D. 742, Bill, "An Act Imposing Term Limits on Legislative
Leadership Positions"

Amend the amendment by striking out everything after the
title and inserting in its place the following:

'Amend the bill by striking out everything after the
enacting clause and before the statement of fact and inserting in
its place the following:

'Sec. 1. 3 MRSA §24 is enacted to read:

§24. Floor leaders; term limitation

A person may not serve in the Senate as party floor leader
or assistant party floor leader for more than 3 consecutive
legislative bienniums.

Sec. 2. 3 MRSA §44 is enacted to read:

§44. Floor leaders; term limitation

A person may not serve in the House of Representatives as
party floor leader, assistant party floor leader or whip for more
than 3 consecutive legislative bienniums.

Sec. 3. Application. Service before the 117th Legislature is
not included in the calculation of years served under this Act.' '
