Sec. 1. Incinerator ash recycling and reuse study. Resolved: the Maine Waste Management Agency, Office of Waste Reduction and Recycling shall prepare a study of innovative technologies for the recycling and reuse of incinerator ash that results from the municipal industrial combustion of and solid waste waste-to-energy facilities. The office shall submit its study report, recommendations and implementing legislation to the Joint Standing Committee on Energy and Natural Resources by January 1, 1994. The cost of this study is an administrative expense that must be paid by the Maine Solid Waste Management Fund established in the Maine Revised Statutes, Title 38, section 2201.

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STATEMENT OF FACT

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This resolve requires the Maine Waste Management Agency, Office of Waste Reduction and Recycling to conduct a study of innovative technologies for the recycling and reuse of incinerator ash. The office is required to submit its study report, recommendations and any implementing legislation to the Joint Standing Committee on Energy and Natural Resources by January 1, 1994.

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
