HOUSE AMENDMENT "¹" to COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 584, L.D. 788, Bill, "An Act to Prevent Unauthorized Use of the Name Passamaquoddy"

Amend the amendment in section 1 in that part designated "<u>\$6-A.</u>" in subsection 3 in paragraph B in the 2nd line (page 2, line 10 in amendment) by striking out the following: "<u>January 1, 1993</u>" and inserting in its place the following: '<u>the effective date of this Act</u>'

Further amend the amendment in section 1 in that part designated "<u>\$6-A.</u>" in subsection 3 in paragraph B in the last paragraph in the 3rd line (page 2, line 20 in amendment) by striking out the following: "January 1, 1993" and inserting in its place the following: 'the effective date of this Act'

Further amend the amendment in section 1 in that part designated "<u>\$6-A.</u>" in subsection 3 in paragraph B in the last paragraph in the last 2 lines (page 2, lines 21 and 22 in amendment) by striking out the following: "<u>January 1, 1993</u>" and inserting in its place the following: '<u>the effective date of</u> <u>this Act</u>'

Further amend the amendment by striking out all of section 2.
