	17-A. Baiting wild birds or wild animals. A person is
6	guilty of baiting a wild bird or wild animal if, during the open
	<u>hunting season on a wild bird or wild animal, that person places</u>
8	bait, salt or any food to entice wild birds or wild animals to
	that location or any person hunts over that bait. This
10	prohibition does not apply to:
12	A. Baiting bear during the baiting season on bear;
14	B. Baiting coyote between December 15th and July 31st; and
