16. Amend the amendment by striking out everything after the title and inserting in its place the following:

'Amend the bill by inserting before the statement of fact 20 the following:

'Sec. 7. Statutory referendum procedure; submission at statewide election; form of question; effective date. This Act must be submitted
to the legal voters of the State of Maine at a statewide election to be held on the Tuesday following the first Monday of November
following passage of this Act. The municipal officers of this State shall notify the inhabitants of their respective cities,
towns and plantations to meet, in the manner prescribed by law for holding a statewide election, to vote on the acceptance or rejection of this Act by voting on the following question:

"Do you favor the enactment of a law requiring that at least one parent of a pregnant minor be notified before the minor has an abortion?"

36 The legal voters of each city, town and plantation shall vote by ballot on this question and shall designate their choice 38 by a cross or check mark placed within a corresponding square below the word "Yes" or "No." The ballots must be received, 40 sorted, counted and declared in open ward, town and plantation meetings and returns made to the Secretary of State in the same 42 manner as votes for members of the Legislature. The Governor shall review the returns and, if it appears that a majority of 44 the legal votes are cast in favor of the Act, the Governor shall

proclaim that fact without delay, and the Act takes effect 30 days after the date of the proclamation.

The Secretary of State shall prepare and furnish to each city, town and plantation all ballots, returns and copies of this
Act necessary to carry out the purpose of this referendum.' '

STATEMENT OF FACT

This amendment strikes the advisory referendum required by 12 Committee Amendment "A" and adds a referendum clause to the bill, requiring a statewide vote in November on whether the bill should 14 become law.
